Minutes of a meeting held at the Village Hall, Winsley

On the 5th July 2016 at 8pm

The meeting commenced at 8pm

23. The minutes of the meeting held on the 7th June 2016, were signed as a true record of the meeting.

24. Police Report: Previously circulated by email, PCSO Andrew McLachlan ran through the report and explained that his work rota meant he would not always be able to attend but would send someone else if possible. Cllrs. agreed that while they felt attendance was beneficial it was probably low priority so long as written reports were available.

Declarations of Interest: None

Public Participation:

Mr Micklam introduced Mr Williams and gave a brief explanation of his role for the Cotswold Warden.

Ms. Parr spoke on the safety issues on the by-pass and the situation regarding the accident on her property. She also asked that the bus shelters be cleaned.

Mr. Berry noted that the dog fouling bins had not been included on the agenda this or last month. It was reported that the process was being held up by the confirmation that these bins would be emptied by the WC contractor. Clerk to chase. Mr. Berry was thanked for his input to the list of accidents that have occurred on the by-pass since its construction.

25. Magnus MacDonald: gave his report, the main item being the new parish steward scheme and how best Winsley might make use of it.

26. Safety on the by-pass: it was agreed by unanimous vote that Cllrs. Warren, Kidney and Barnes should meet with D Thomas of WC to discuss possible action. It was also reported by Cllr. Warren that there were parts of the 20 mph project that were not complete but also not needed. Cllrs. queried the costs presented at CATG and in relation to the Winsley contribution of

£1800. It was left with Cllrs. Warren and Kidney to gather information on the road painting to be undertaken on Dane Rise and to cancel the RED painting in Turleigh. It was felt that the paint was probably more important to Dane Rise. They were also asked to speak to D Thomas about the possibility of a footpath at the more dangerous end of the road where children access the school through the play area.

27. Planning:

16/04690/FUL Heartwood House, 91b Winsley Hill. It was agreed by unanimous vote that this application should be called to committee should the case officer be minded to approve it. Key reason being that it was unreasonable development within an AONB.

16/05600/FUL Land below Turleigh Croft, Turleigh. It was agreed by unanimous vote that councillors neither object nor support this application but they do make the following comments: the land should not support more than one horse, there should be provision for removal of waste within the proposal, the concrete rafting should be removed and it should not be for commercial purposes.

16/04925/LBC and 16/02953/FUL The Lyns, Turleigh. No comment by unanimous vote.
