Minutes of a meeting held at the Village Hall, Winsley

On the 8th August 2016 at 8pm

The meeting commenced at 8pm

32. The minutes of the meeting held on the 5th July 2016, were signed as a true record of the meeting, with one minor amendment.

33. Police Report: This was not available.

Declarations of Interest: None

34. Matters arising from the previous meeting:

It was reported that Mr Kemmery had said he would prefer not to have a formal celebration of his recent award and it was agreed that the Parish Council should write congratulating him.

It was also reported that the application at Heartswood House had been approved and that the permission for the land below Turleigh Croft had been refused.

Public Participation:

Mr. Drower asked why the council do not include a description of the planning application on the agenda. It was noted that this had been discussed at length several times in the past.

The applicant's representative spoke for 3 minutes on the planning application for 139 Winsley.

Mr. Drower, Ms. Walker and Mr. Mead spoke against the application.

Mr. Sealey made observations on the appearance of the scheme.

Ms. O'Connor asked that the council take a vote from those present on whether they supported the application or not. It was explained that this was a public participation section where members of the public have the opportunity to come and say what they feel about any matter on the agenda. Members of the public decided to stand in order to signify objection to the application. 10 people then stood.

Planning:

35. 16/06371/FUL 45 Murhill – no comment by unanimous vote.

36. 16/06851/FUL 139 Winsley. This application was discussed at length and finally it was agreed by majority vote that this should be called to the planning committee. The specific reasons and comment to be agreed later by the Clerk over email with Councillors but the basis being the parking provision and the impact on the conservation area. Disappointment was also noted that Wiltshire Councillor Magnus McDonald had already actioned a call in. However, it was also noted that this could be withdrawn and that in order to ensure that the local comment was noted it was important to disregard this fact.
