Minutes of a meeting held at the Church Hall, Winsley

On the 1st November 2016 at 8pm

The meeting commenced at 8pm

57. The minutes of the meeting held on the 4th October 2016, were signed as a true record of the meeting.

Declarations of Interest: Cllr. Kemp declared an interest in a planning application made by her 16/09588/FUL.

Public Participation:

58. Matters arising. It was reported by Cllr. Kidney that 3 of the 4 new bins were now in position. Near neighbours to the proposed site in Turleigh had objected and a new site for the last bin would be decided shortly. It was agreed that they would probably need to be emptied weekly.

59. Winsley Hill Action Group: representatives of this group came to speak on the work they had started and the areas in which they needed PC support. Key issues are the speed of traffic traveling down the hill, parking on the hill, the termination of the path at the point where the road crosses the canal and the condition of the road as it passes under the railway bridge.

Planning:

60. 16/09259/FUL Dorothy House, Winsley. After some discussion, it was agreed that Winsley Parish Council did not have any objection to the scheme. However, they do welcome the further discussion and improvements which will go some way to limiting its impact on the residents of Murhill and Westwood. No objection by unanimous vote.

61. 16/09658/FUL . Workshop building to the south east of 115 Winsley, No comment, by unanimous vote. Assuming that the parking and access is taken into account.

62. 16/09588/FUL Land off Ashley Lane, no comment on the general scheme but conditions that it should be for personal and details of handling of animal waste should be given. In addition councillors ask that there be provision for safe entrance and exit

and for there to be parking while the gates were open. By unanimous vote.

63. 16/09832/FUL 3 Dane Close, Winsley

No comment by unanimous vote.

64. 16/09478/FUL 5 St Nicholas Close, Winsley

No comment by unanimous vote.

65. Safety and maintenance issues on Winsley Hill and on the B3108:

Thanks were offered on behalf of the council to Cllr. Barnes for all of his hard work on these issues.

A list of priorities was discussed with the final order to be decided and circulated after the meeting.

It was proposed that a councillors working group should be formed comprised of Cllrs. Kidney, Warren, Barnes and Gilby.

It was agreed that they would update and draw on Cllr.

MacDonald when needed.

Whether a non-councillor could be appointed as the Parish Steward coordinator was discussed to be checked with Wiltshire Council.
