

Winsley Parish Council
Highways and Transport Advisory Group – April 2022

This report is to summarise the outstanding Highways and Transport issues currently with Wiltshire Council for further action.

1. B3108 Speed limit review and outcome of the survey carried out by Wiltshire Council in the Tynings Road, Dane Rise and Hartley Farm lane area to determine any engineering and safety requirements.
2. Active travel route from Winsley (Ashley Lane) to Downs View Bradford on Avon.
3. Double yellow lines:
Lower Winsley Hill – an initial response has been that these were only being considered for the stretch below the Canal Bridge. This despite photographic evidence provided by the PC over several weeks demonstrating the greater extent of the problem. We are promised that this will be reconsidered following strong representations and additional evidence.

Winsley Village by St. Nicholas Church.

Wiltshire Council will provide the PC with their proposals before going to public consultation.

4. Cleaning and repairing of signs showing access restrictions into Old Village.
5. Footway signage on the path between Millbourne Close and the Old Village.
6. School Entrance road markings and hatching.
7. Turleigh – proposal to alleviate problems and damage caused by larger vehicles using the road as a “through route”.

The date of the next CATG meeting has yet to be confirmed.
