

## Proposed Parking Restrictions – Winsley Village

The Parish Council was asked to assist in resolving the issue of obstruction caused by parked vehicles in the vicinity of St Nicholas Church. This is a very narrow stretch of the highway. As a result Wiltshire Highways have visited the area and suggested a short section of double yellow lines, location on the attached plan.

Double yellow lines will not prevent funeral vehicles parking outside of the Church. In any event they are not left unattended for more than a few minutes.

Before placing before the Parish Council at the May meeting comments have been sought from residents who live in the immediate vicinity. 1 Resident has strongly objected for several reasons including the application of yellow lines being detrimental to the area, they'll not be enforced, the problem is caused by the Village Club and there is little space anyway for residents to park.

3 reacted positively, 1 being a Church representative.

The cost for lining if consulted upon with Lower Winsley Hill will be £1000. Hopefully 50% paid by LHFIG.
