Temporary changes to buses through Winsley

from 25 July 2022 to 2 September 2022

From Monday 25 July, the road between Winsley and Bradford on Avon will be closed for 6 weeks to enable a permanent cycle path to be installed.

Unfortunately, this means that the D1 bus service will not be able to follow its normal route and will NOT be able to serve Winsley village or Limpley Stoke and instead will operate via Sally-in-the-Woods.

In its place the following alternative transport will be provided from Winsley starting on Monday 25th July 2022:

Winsley to BATH shuttle bus

This will be operated by the 'FirstBus' company between Winsley and Bath. The shuttle bus will operate every day **except** Sundays and Public Holidays, departing from Tyning Road at the following times, then picking up at Bradford Road, The Seven Stars, Dorothy House and Avon Park a few minutes later:

Winsley to BRADFORD ON AVON shuttle bus.

In addition to the Bath shuttle bus, a small Wiltshire Council minibus will operate a service between **Winsley and Bradford on Avon** non-stop via Turleigh, every day **except** Sundays and Public Holidays. The minibus will depart from Tyning Road at the times shown below, then will pick up at the bus stops opposite Dorothy House and the Seven Stars and also on Bradford Road near the bottom of Dane Rise, a few minutes later:
